

## Suggested Provisions of the Illegal Alien Bill for Indiana

- All employers of Indiana whether headquartered in Indiana or not but have employees in Indiana shall follow these provisions.
- Employers regardless of size of workforce shall not hire, contract with, compensate or in any other manner knowingly employ Illegal Aliens.
- To insure that all employees are legal and within the laws of the United States of America and Indiana can and should use two Federally provided and funded program called “**Systematic Alien Verification for Entitlements**” (**SAVE**) **program and Basic Pilot (which requires Federal form 1-9)**. Both of these programs are easily accessible through the computer and are fast method of insuring the hiring of legal aliens. Any employer who uses these programs is safe from prosecution of this law but must discontinue employing any violators. Some companies who presently use Basic Pilot are listed on the following page.
- Any illegal alien caught defrauding the citizens of Indiana shall be subject to a minimum of two years in jail or accept our offer to transport them and their families to the border. All Illegal Aliens who are caught the second time shall receive a mandatory sentence of 2 years and then be transported to the border.
- Any person, company or corporation who violates this law shall be prosecuted under this law and shall subject to the following.

### First Offense:

- Up to 2 years in prison but no less than 90 days.
- A fine of \$5,000 per offense which shall be paid to the Indiana Homeland Security Agency to offset transporting costs. The Judge hearing such case shall have no discretion on the fine and may not sentence violator any less than 90 days for the first offense.

### Second Offense:

- Up to 5 years in prison but no less than 2 years.
- A fine of \$20,000 per offense which shall be paid to the Indiana Homeland Security Agency. The Judge hearing such case shall have no discretion on the fine and may not sentence violator any less than 2 years for the second offense.

- Any law enforcement agency who receives a complaint on a company that is allegedly hiring Illegal Aliens must act as with 72 hours of call. They shall not give an employer that a raid on his business is going to take place or he shall be liable to the same penalties.
- Any prosecutor who does not prosecute this crime shall be guilty of negligence and shall be brought before the Supreme Court for actions and possible removal from office.
- English shall be the official language of Indiana.
